A beautiful combination of Buketraube and Weiser Riesling. Pale straw in colour, with aromas of peaches, pineapple, honey, muscat and delicate fruit salad that follows through on the semi-sweet palate.

Serve with curries, Thai food, Eastern dishes and blue cheese.

Trellised vines planted on southeast-facing slopes yielded the grapes for this wine. The vines received supplementary irrigation and produced 7 tons per hectare.

about the harvest: The grapes were harvested at 24.7° Balling.

in the cellar : The juice was fermented at 14°C Celsius for 27 days and was given 10 hours of skin contact.
