

Groot Constantia Bouquet Blanc 2004

A charming semi-sweet wine made from morio muscat grapes. Inviting whiffs of rose-petals, apricots and honey on the nose. Pineapple and lime flavours follows through on the palate. The sweetness of the wine is well balanced with a lively acidity, to be enjoyed now at it's fragrant best.

Serve as an aperitif with fresh melon and parma ham or with spicy Thai food.
