in the cellar : A wood matured blend of 80% Shiraz and 20% Cabernet Sauvignon.
Matured 15 months in 100% 3rd fill French Oak barrels.
Length of fermentation: Shiraz - 8 days on skins, Cabernet Sauvignon - 19 days on skins
