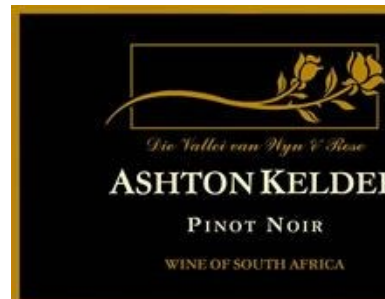


Ashton Kelder Pinot Noir 2003
