Blackforest ham, duck or chicken with roasted vegetables.

**in the vineyard :** Climate: Mediterranean " Moderate summers and cold wet winters.

The average rainfall is approximately 600 - 700 mm per year.

**about the harvest:** Selected grapes were harvested at 23 " Balling.

**in the cellar :** Fermented on the skins until dry. After malolactic fermentation took place, the wine was matured in 300 litre French oak barrels for 14 months. Then blended, fined, stabilised and bottled.
