Colour: Salmon pink.

Bouquet: Berries and subtle yet peppery herbaceous aromas.

Taste: The berries follow through onto the palate, resulting in a well balanced, pleasant and mouth-filling wine.

Planted between 1991 and 1996 the vineyards grow on westerly and south-westerly facing slopes, 95 m above sea level. The vines grafted onto nematode-resistant Richter 99 and 110 rootstocks are trellised on a five-wire system and receive supplementary irrigation from an overhead sprinkler system.

about the harvest: The grapes were harvested by hand and machine in late February between 24Â° and 25Â° Balling.

in the cellar : They were then crushed, the juice separated from the skins and fermented for 16 days at 14Â°C.
