Rich, banana and sun-ripe plum notes, lead to a ripe fruit laden palate with soft tannins and long fruity finish.

Ideal with pizza and pasta dishes.

Named after the famous master road builder Andrew Bain who created the gateway to the north through Bainskloof Pass.

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**about the harvest:** The grapes were picked at optimum maturity.

**in the cellar :** Fermented dry on the skins at 28°C. Thereafter the free run portion was placed in second and third fill oak barrels for 9 to 12 months.
