about the harvest: Handpicked at optimum ripeness to reveal rich black fruit characters. The year 2001 produced wines that were fruit driven and "feminine" - this wine demonstrates these characteristics.

in the cellar : Handpicked, crushed and inoculated - made in a combination of vinification from punch down to cerated pump over. The wine went through malolactic fermentation and was matured in French Oak barrels for 12 months.
