ageing : Drink within 2 years of vintage.

in the vineyard : Vineyard: Bush Vine, no irrigation.

Terrior: Deep soils from decomposed granite, clay rich, with good drainage.

Climate: Vineyards strategically planted on South-West facing slopes to capture cool breezes from the Atlantic Ocean and cold Benguela current.

about the harvest: Crush and destalk, 14 days fermentation at 13Â°C. Grapes and juice handled reductively to prevent oxidation.

in the cellar : Left on lees for 2 months to add complexity.
