in the vineyard : Average age of vines: Cabernet Sauvignon 18 years and Shiraz 12 years

Soils: Yellowish brown, duplex soils with clay underlying a gravely type soil

Trellis: Cabernet Sauvignon - 5 m wire extended perold hedge & Shiraz - 7m wire extended perold hedge

Pruning: Spur pruned

about the harvest: Grapes are handpicked. Cabernet Sauvignon beginning to mid March & Shiraz " Late February to early March.

in the cellar : Selected the healthiest grapes. Fermented in tanks until dry. The wine racked, the skins are pressed and malo-lactic fermentation is completed.
