in the vineyard : Vineyards: Bush vines/dryland

Terroir: Deep soils from decomposed granite.

Climate: Warm sunny days and the moderating influence of the Atlantic Ocean.

about the harvest: Crush and destalk, 12 days fermentation at 22-28°C.

in the cellar : After malolactic fermentation, wine is raked into barrels for 10 months. A blend of 3rd and 4th fill barrels are used.
