Bronze - International Wine and Spirit Competition (IWSC) 2005

Ripe and spicy fruit flavours dominate this wild, aromatic red blend. It is rich, juicy and full with a generous texture. French oaking detail is obvious on the nose and palate and extends to the lengthy, elegant finish of this wine.
