

Waverley Hills Shiraz 2004

Purple red in colour, this wine has a complex array of aromas of ripe plums and spicy notes of white pepper rounded with peppermint crisp chocolate flavours. â€œFynbosâ€ (garrigue), character of â€œtolbosâ€ (indigenous flora) and liquorice in the after-taste best illustrates the terroir. The most distinguishing attributes of this wine are a soft entry and long lingering after-taste.

Serve and enjoy with light fresh foods like pastas and salads or meat dishes. This wine is a perfect fit for the health-conscious wine lover.

about the harvest: Only the finest full ripe grapes were hand-picked and sorted in the vineyard before being gently de-stemmed and crushed.

in the cellar : The grapes were cold macerated for a week to extract the flavours from the skins. Matured with French oak and American oak staves for 4 months, the wine was then blended with 7% Cabernet Sauvignon of the same vintage.
