

Roberts Rock Pinotage/Pinot Noir 2004

A light wine with a serious side, exhibiting youthful characteristics throughout. The appearance is purplish red, the aromas fresh raspberry and strawberry and beetroot-like. The flavours are similar with a sprinkling of spicy oak. Elegantly structured ripe fruit.

Informally "â€" on its own or with a smoked beef salad. A sociable wine.
