

Cape View Cabernet Sauvignon 1999

This medium-bodied wine with a healthy ruby red colour has good varietal identity. Fresh and vibrant with layers of summer berry flavours complemented by hints of chocolate and spicy vanilla oak. Tannins are soft; the acids gentle and ripe berry fruit is integrated to produce a clean, balanced wine.

A good match for pasta with meat sauce, grilled vegetables, meat casseroles.

about the harvest: Grapes harvested at optimum ripeness.

in the cellar : Fermented dry on the skins. Gently pressed and matured with new French oak for 3 months.
