

## Bains Way Chardonnay 2005

Yellow peach aromas on the nose transpire into delicate but bright tropical fruit flavours on the palate. An easy-drinking yet elegant Chardonnay in a modern style.

An excellent match with chicken and white meats and wonderfully refreshing on its own.

**about the harvest**: Grapes were picked at optimum ripeness from about 25° Balling.

**in the cellar** : After the crush, the juice was left on the skins for 3 to 5 hours and then pressed. Only free run juice were used and the fermentation temperature was about 13°C.
