

Beau Joubert Sauvignon Blanc 2005

Appearance has a green tint with pale straw centre, bright, clear and brilliant. A gooseberry, guava and pineapple with medium forward intensity, comes through on the nose. Palate has a soft, clean entry with a balanced acidity. Good follow through. Slightly short finish but good fruit on mid palate.

Drinks well now and will go well with fish and cheese.

in the vineyard : This single block scales roughly 150 meters (500 feet) vertically over approximately 5 hectares or 12.5 acres. The fruit has been picked at 3 different times due to the phenolic ripening of the grapes.
