Deep, dark colour with aromas of blackcurrants and subtle wood on the nose. A great concentration of fruit on the palate supported with finely balanced tannins. A wonderfully soft and smooth finish.

in the vineyard : Terroir: Warmer sites are selected to give full ripe grapes with dark colour and soft tannins. Soils from decomposed granite. Hutton soils dominate the sites selected for this wine

Vineyard type: Bush Vine, no irrigation

about the harvest: Yield: 6-7 t/ha

Balling at Harvest: 24-25Â°B

in the cellar : Vinification: Crush and destalk, 16 days fermentation at 22-28Â°C .

Maturation: After malolactic fermentation, wine is racked into barrels for 12 months.

A blend of 3rd and 4th fill barrels are used.
