Deep mulberry and ruby hues. Black currant, cassis and spices, from eight months in wood. Palate sweetish and dense, richly textured, not over concentrated. Good, supple, dry tannins. Long-lasting, savoury finish. Been described as 'an excellent buy at the price'.
