Grape Varieties: Colombard

Age of vineyards planted: 13 years

**about the harvest:** The grapes were harvested at 21.5° Balling

**in the cellar :** Whole berries were destemmed. Only free running juice was used. The wine had 4 hours skin contact. After the wine was fermented dry, it was racked, filtered and bottled.
