

Vergenoegd Reserve 1994

The Vergenoegd Reserve is a blended wine, consisting mainly of Cabernet Sauvignon complemented by Merlot and Cabernet Franc.

Colour : Lustrous. Deep, rich and red indicating length of skin contact.

Nose : Intense berry fruit complemented by mint and vanilla.

Taste : Rich berry fruit of Cabernet Sauvignon complemented by softness of Merlot and accessibility of Cabernet Franc. Good fruit acid balance with ripe tannins, clean finish.

variety : Cabernet Sauvignon | 57% Cabernet Sauvignon, 22% Merlot, 21% Cabernet Franc

winery : Vergenoegd Löw The Wine Estate

winemaker : John Faure

wine of origin : Stellenbosch

type : Red **style :** Dry **wooded**

Cabernet Sauvignon - 19 March 1994

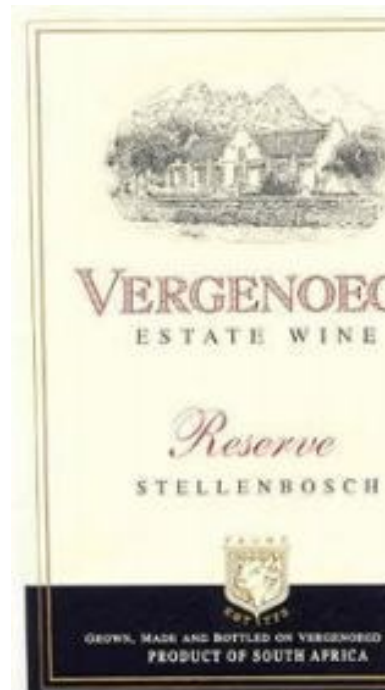
Merlot - 25 February 1994
