in the vineyard : Vergenoegd Estate makes use of the Tinta Barocca cultivar for the production of their Port which they have been producing for a number of years, the first vintage being bottled in 1986.

The vines are grown on the deep rich alluvial soils laid down by the Eerste River in former years. Harvesting only takes place when the grapes are fully ripe so as to capture as much natural sweetness in the final wine as possible.
