Turkish delight-like nose mingles with honeysuckle and jasmine. Added complexity from some botrytis. Slow flow across the palate with tropical fruit salad in the mouth. Rich and full mouth feel with luscious, yet balanced finish with enough zesty acid to make whole mouth appear smooth and rounded rather than particularly sweet. Delicious!

ageing : Excellent now, enjoy in the next three to four years.

in the vineyard : Age of vineyards: 15 years

about the harvest: The grapes were harvested at 27° Balling. Grapes were brought in during early hours while the grapes were still cold.

Yield: 10 tons/ha
