ageing : It is well structured with soft tannins and has a maturation potential of ten years.

in the vineyard : Climate: Wet winters and warm summers, tempered by cool ocean breezes from over the mountain.

Soil: Weathered granite and clovelly from Paarl Mountain.

about the harvest: Grapes were harvested above 23Å° Balling.

in the cellar : The juice was fermented dry on the skins. The wine was matured in 300 litre French oak barrels for twelvemonths. No filtration.
