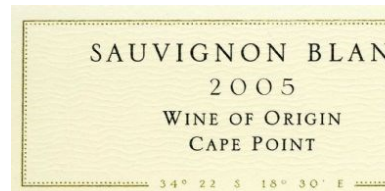


## Cape Point Vineyards Sauvignon Blanc 2005

The wine shows a complex array of tropical fruit, with subtle herbaceous tones and an incredible mineral backbone. The palate is rich and full made in a style to be a wonderful food companion.

**ageing** : This Sauvignon Blanc is drinking beautifully at present, but try to exercise patience as it will only improve over the next 2-3 years.

**about the harvest**: Grapes for this wine are picked on the picturesque south facing Noordhoek slopes from the Peninsulas' southern most vineyards. The grapes were harvested between 22°B and 23.5°B in the early hours of the morning and were all hand-picked.
