The wine is dark ruby in colour with an inviting nose of roasted almonds, fresh cherries and a hint of tobacco. An abundance of cherry and tobacco follow through to a rich, well-balanced palate.

Viticulture:

Trellised, 8 year-old vines planted on southeast-facing slopes yielded the grapes for this wine. The vineyards received supplementary drip irrigation and produced 8 tons per hectare.

about the harvest: Grapes were harvested from selected vineyard blocks at 25.7° Balling.

in the cellar : Cold soaked for 2 - 3 days at 13-14°C. Following fermentation in stainless steel tanks, wines from specific tanks were selected to undergo malolactic fermentation in oak barrels. The wine matured in a combination of French- and American oak.
