DWYKA IS A KAROO ROCK STRATUM WHICH WAS Laid DOWN DURING THE ICE AGE 300 MILLION YEARS AGO. COMPOSED OF A MATRIX OF MUD AND 'DROPSTONES', IT CREATED A COMPACT LAYER KNOWN AS TILLITE THAT HAS CHARACTERISTIC STRIATIONS AND TEXTURES. IN WORCESTER SOUTH AFRICA, THE TILLITE STRATUM HAS UNDERGONE VERTICAL MOVEMENTS AND WEATHERING HAS CREATED DRAMATIC 'TOMBSTONE' SHAPED
