The wine has a brilliant golden yellow colour with a characteristic bouquet of fresh, ripe tropical fruit and a hint of yeastiness from the lees contact. Flavours of ripe guava and upfront pineapple on the palate. This is a rich and full bodied wine with an excellent wine/fruit balance.
