Vineyards are situated on south- and south eastly a slope which receives cool air and is therefore retains the flavours in the grapes.

about the harvest: Grapes were picked at optimum physiological ripeness and handled reductive through the whole process to optimize fruit retention.

in the cellar : 3 Months lees contact were allowed followed by bottling.
