Jacques Bruwer, the winemaker initiated a flagship range, called Inkarã. Inkarã is a play on his children–s names (Inge, Karli and Andr–©) and it pays tribute to the fourth generation of Bruwer–s on the Estate. Since its launch in 2001, this premium range has proven to produce excellent wines.

These wines are produced only from single vineyards. Both the Inkarã Shiraz and Inkarã Cabernet Sauvignon have been recognized for their superior quality.

Complex amalgam red berried fruit, chocolate, espresso, mulberry with sweet spice and smoky oak. Wafts of Karoo bos penetrate all other aromas. Silky textured pallet with supple tannins and lots of horsepower.
