Colour: Pale straw with a greenish tint.

Bouquet: Aromas of freshly-cut grass, gooseberries, green peppers and herbs.

Enjoy on its own or with either cold meats or seafood.

The grapes were sourced mainly from trellised vineyards on the cool Stellenbosch slopes, either south-facing or at higher altitudes where maritime breezes helped to reduce temperatures during the final stages of ripening.

The vines grow in soils originating mainly from decomposed granite, although some Table Mountain sandstone has been discovered at the vineyards.

about the harvest: The grapes were harvested by hand at between 22.5° and 23.5° Balling.
