This medium to light-bodied Rosé has a deep rose colour and displays strawberry flavours with a hint of floral aromas on the nose, whilst the palate is soft and fruity with hints of strawberry flavours.

in the vineyard : Drostdy-Hof Rosé is a blend of Cabernet Sauvignon, Pinotage and Pinot Noir grapes selected from vineyards in the coastal region

about the harvest: The grapes were harvested at 22-23° Balling during February and March.

in the cellar : All the vineyard blocks were individually vinified. The juice was fermented on the skins at 14°C for 12 hours, then drawn off the skins and fermented dry to ensure prominent fruitiness.
