

Shepherd's Cottage Cabernet Sauvignon/Merlot 2005

A 60/40 blend, where Cabernet Sauvignon contributes rich black berry flavours and structure and the Merlot juicy black cherry flavours with a hint of chocolate. A voluptuous, generous, smooth textured wine.

Enjoy on its own or with mutton chops, leg of lamb, steak or a sumptuous meat dish.

As with all the wines produced in the Overgaauw cellar the Shepard's Cottage wines carry a quality signature: the commitment from the winemaking team to produce the best from the carefully nurtured fruit the harvest has to offer.

The Shepherd's Cottage at Overgaauw was originally built in the late 1700's to house the local Shepherd. It is a small quaint humble home, with thick old white washed walls and small windows which are protected by green shutters, each with a heart carved out in its centre. Four generations of van Veldens have made wine at Overgaauw and for the last two generations the newly wed van Velden children have had the privilege of calling this their home for the first few years of their married life.

Along with the rest of the Shepard's Cottage range of wines this red celebrates the warmth, commitment and love shared in this humble home.

about the harvest: The Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot grapes were harvested at 24.8Â°C.

Harvest date: Cabernet Sauvignon grapes harvested in February and March, Merlot in February

Yield per hectare: Cabernet Sauvignon 6 tons/ha and Merlot 8 tons/ha
