Complex citrus flavours with a powerful nose filled with lime and grapefruit followed through with an interesting spicy palate reflecting the terroir and vintage. The fruit on the palate is enhanced by the $\frac{1}{2}$ subtle oaking, resulting in a lingering finish.

Grande Provence Chardonnay is a perfect match for rich creamy dishes, spiked with a bit of spice! Enjoy with smoked salmon or Franschhoek smoked trout, with fresh lime or perfectly matured Chevin or Brie.
