The 1998 Blanc de Blanc has an individual bouquet with layers of fruit. The palate bombards the senses with litchi, peach and guava flavours and lingers tantalisingly on the after-palate. An elegant, finely structured wine to enjoy with creamy pasta or fish dishes or even with cheese souffl  s.
