

Lanzerac Chardonnay 1998

The 1998 Chardonnay offers a melange of citrus scents on the nose, followed through by crisp, fruity flavours backed by oak vanillins. It is recommended as a warm day sipping wine or as a partner to seafood and poultry dishes, including game birds.
