

Eaglevei Cabernet Sauvignon Reserve 2006

A delicately textured wine with layers of eucalyptus & chocolate strawberries on the nose. A full bodied blackberry palate that is fair game for a nice steak or lamb shank.

Serve with pasta, cheese and red meat dishes.

CABERNET SAUVIGNON makes the most dependable candidate for aging, more often improving into a truly great wine than any other single varietal. It is actually the hybrid offspring of Sauvignon Blanc and Cabernet Franc.

ageing : Enjoy now or within 2 - 4 years from harvest.

in the vineyard : The vineyard received supplementary drip irrigation and produced 8 tons/ha.

about the harvest: Grapes were handpicked at full ripeness.
