An easy-drinking and supple wine that's pale straw in colour with a creamy tinge. It offers an earnest fruity character on the nose and a lively crispness on the palate from the Colombar. The Chardonnay provides a prominent roundness in flavour. The overall result is succulent juiciness.

A delicious summer-timewine to enjoy slightly chilled on its own anytime or with salads, vegetarian dishes or spicy Eastern meals.
