

Warwick Cabernet Franc 1994

A powerful herbaceous nose with a rich mouth-filling front palate. A concentration of sweet plum and blackcurrant, laced together by careful wood ageing, gives this wine a long dry finish with hints of licorice. WNE ***** " Deep plum. Rich, intense nose with spicy, tobacco, sweet cassis and chocolate aromas. Ripe, red berry fruit combined with spicy, cinnamon oak flavours. Chocolatey. Firm, dry but ripe tannins. Has power, density and personality. A classic claret."
