Deep dark ruby red centre and cherry red edge. The nose is full bodied with fruit from cassis and black current. The wood is balanced with hints of vanilla and cedar box wood note. The wine is dry with big firm ripe subtle tannins. The follow through from the nose is fulfilled with intense dark and red berry flavours. The integration of the wood, alcohol and the ripe soft tannins create a solid platform of complexity and depth which will allow the wine to age with multiple layers.
