

Nederburg The Winemasters Reserve Baronne (Cabernet Sauvignon Shiraz) 2006

Colour: Ruby red.

Bouquet: Sweet-scented Satsuma plum, red berries with cassis and herbs.

Palate: A smooth, velvety, medium-bodied wine, with juicy plum, cherry fruit and spicy wood flavours.

Serve with heartwarming roast lamb, coq au vin, steak, venison, mature cheeses, pizza and pasta dishes.

in the vineyard :

The grapes were sourced from vineyards in the Paarl and Stellenbosch areas. Planted between 1990 and 1998 in soil of decomposed granite, the vineyards face south-westerly to westerly at an altitude of 300 m. The vines, grafted onto nematode resistant rootstock Richter 99, 110 and 101-114 receive supplementary irrigation by means of an overhead sprinkler system.

about the harvest:

The grapes were harvested by hand and machine between 23Â° and 24Â° Balling during February and March.

in the cellar :

They were crushed and then cool-fermented in temperature-controlled stainless steel tanks for two weeks between 25Â° and 28Â°C. After malolactic fermentation the wine was matured in wood for a period of 8 to 12 months.
