Rich cherry, strawberries and plums on the nose with ripe red berry fruit and spicy flavours on the palate. Full structured and well balanced with sweet fruit, an elegant mouthfeel and silky soft tannins.

in the vineyard :

Pinotage blocks planted on granite gravels in Firgrove, Stellenbosch and loamy Table mountain sandstone in Franschhoek. Vineyards produce around 6 tons per hectare.

about the harvest: Handpicked at optimum ripeness.

in the cellar :

Fermented in open and closed fermenters with regular punch downs and pump overs. 12 Months maturation in new (30%) and 2nd fill American and French oak.
