

## Graham Beck Shiraz 2004

Ripe mulberry, blueberry and white pepper on the nose with layers of fruit, rich tannins and oak complexity on the palate.

Can be enjoyed with rich casseroles or hearty stews.

**ageing :** This wine will develop for a further 5 - 10 years.

### **in the vineyard :**

Vineyards from four unique areas of which two are ocean influenced and two are more inland. Soils vary from red hutton soils, deep gravel and alluvial layered soil.

### **in the cellar :**

Hand picked at optimum ripeness and fermented in varying methods of punch down, submerged cap and aerated pump overs until dry. After going into press, the wine undergoes malolactic fermentation in stainless steel and is matured in 80% American Oak & 20% French Oak for 13 months.
