A trellised 10 year old vineyard with north/south row direction on deep well drained red clay/lime soil.

**about the harvest:** The grapes were harvested by hand.

**in the cellar :** The grapes were destemmed and left to cold macerate on the skins for 8 hours in stainless steel tanks at 12°C. After this short maceration the grapes were pressed and fermented cool at 13-15°C to ensure a fresh primary fruit bouquet and light pink colour.
