

Bains Way Merlot 2007

A nose of delicious ripe cherries and a hint of oak transcends onto the palate, culminating in plummy flavours and a trace of chocolate.

about the harvest: The grapes were picked at optimum maturity.

in the cellar : After harvesting the grapes were fermented dry on the skins at 28° C. Thereafter the free run portion was placed in second and third fill oak barrels for 8 to 12 months.

Named after the famous master road builder Andrew Bain who created the gateway to the north through Bainskloof Pass.
