Colour: Lovely pale orangey rosé.

Bouquet: Soft fruity aromas with an abundance of strawberry.

Palate: A lively light to medium-bodied wine with a clean, fruity and refreshing finish.

The winemaker suggests serving with smoked salmon, summer salads or vegetarian dishes.

in the vineyard :

The grapes were sourced from vineyards in the Durbanville and Darling areas. Planted between 1985 and 1995, these vineyards grow in decomposed granite, and are situated between 50 m and 150 m above sea level.

about the harvest:

The grapes were harvested by hand between 18th and 19th of February during mid-February.

in the cellar :

They were crushed, receiving 4 to 6 hours of skin contact, and then the juice cool-fermented in temperature-controlled stainless steel tanks for two to three weeks at 13th C, before being left on the lees for a day.
