

## Glen Carlou Quartz Stone Chardonnay 2007

Colour: Subtle straw yellow with green hues.

Aroma: Green apples and gun smoke with hints of sourdough.

Flavour: Layers of apricot and peach, with some grapefruit and boiled sweets.

Finish: Rich, full mouth feel with well-balanced acidity that lingers on the palate for some time.

**about the harvest**: Harvested in February 2007.

**in the cellar** : Fermentation: 4 weeks natural yeast fermentation in barrel

Barrel ageing: 100% New French Oak for 11 months

Bottling date: January 2008
