Beverage Testing Institute World Wine Championships 2009, USA (April) - "Best Buy" and Silver Medal

A lively South African Sauvignon Blanc with fresh tropical fruit flavours, with a touch of grassiness. The freshness is further complimented by well balanced and complex flavors on the palate.

This wine can be enjoyed with any seafood from oysters to smoked fish and gammon. A light chicken dish and asparagus.

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in the vineyard : Climate: Mediterranean climate with warm, dry summers and cold, wet winters, of approximately 600 - 800 mm or rain per year.

Soil: Table Mountain sandstone and Malmesbury shale.

in the cellar : Chosen grapes from cooler areas in the Western Cape were crushed.

After 4 - 8 hours skin contact the juice was fermented at 12°C. Two weeks of lees contact were allowed, then racked, fined, cold stabilized and bottled.
