

## Arniston Bay Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon 2007

Nice cedary Cabernet notes on the nose. Good, smoky complexity on the palate with good concentration and well-integrated, soft tannins.

Serve this wine with lazy-aged beef fillet or rosemary infused lamb.
