

Cape Tranquility Red 2007

A deep, rich, red wine with complex flavours on the nose which carries right through on the palate and can easily be enjoyed.

Boerewors, ostrich sauced meats and lamb curries. Also red meat dishes with sweet and spicy overtones, venison, oxtail, ostrich, briedies and goulash.

in the vineyard : The vines are all trellised and on average 11-12 years of age. Production is between 8-10 tons/ha and we make use of supplementary irrigation.
